

VILLAGE OF ELKHART LAKE

RESIDENTAL REFUSE COLLECTION

Both garbage and recyclables must be placed at curb side every Wednesday prior to 7:00 a.m. Holiday collection—if holiday is on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday pick up is on Thursday.

GARBAGE 2-cubic yards per week. 10-thirteen (13) gallon clear bags or 3-thirty (30) gallon clear bags. No black bags. If you are moving out you need to use a dumpster.

RECYCLABLES-must be in blue bags. Items should be rinsed clean.

Items include: aluminum cans, trays, foil, steel & tin food cans, glass & plastic bottles #1-#5 and #7. Do not include styrofoam packing, plastic oil bottles, plastic cups, light bulbs, firm hard plastic (toys, pails, flower pots, etc.), window or auto glass, drinking glasses, caps or lids, plastic bags, and ceramics.

PAPER, MAGAZINES, NEWSPAPERS, CARDBOARD items can be put in brown paper bags, bundled with string, or placed in a cardboard box. (They must not be in plastic bags and no waxed cardboard). Cardboard boxes must be broken down and bundled. They will also accept shredded paper, junk mail, envelopes (including window envelopes). Do not include styrofoam, tissue products, paper toweling, holiday wrapping paper, frozen food boxes, pizza or carryout boxes, and contaminated paper.

HEAVY REFUSE COLLECTION

Household items-couch, chair, carpeting (cut in 6 ft. strips & rolled), tables, stove, washer, dryer, etc. Tires will be picked up for a fee.

Call Veolia's to arrange pickup on the normal garbage collection day.

HEAVY REFUSE CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS

2-30 gallon garbage cans will be allowed at no cost, any more than this must be called into Larry's hauling and placed in a dumpster & billed per yard. Construction items include: 2x4's, drywall and metal.

FREON PICK UP (refrigerator, freezer, dehumidifiers)

These item must be called in to Larry's hauling to make payment arrangements (\$25.00). They will be picked up curbside on your scheduled garbage day.

ELECTRONIC ITEMS CAN NO LONGER BE PUT IN THE TRASH

(TV's, computers & components, printers, fax machines, DVD's, & VCR's.)

Try to trade in old electronics with the store when you buy new.

WASTE OIL

A drum for collection of waste oil only is located on the north side of the village garage, 51 E. Maple St.

YARD WASTE

Yard waste, leaves/brush/garden debris etc. will not be picked up curbside. A dumpster and brush truck will be provided at the village garage from April thru October. Current hours are Wednesday 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Saturday 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

BRUSH TRUCK

There is a brush truck which is available for you to put in large amounts of brush. Call the village garage at 876-2231 to arrange a time.

SENIOR CITIZEN PICKUP

Call the village garage at 876-2231 by the previous Friday to arrange pickup on the last Monday of the month.
