



**ORDINANCE 553
VILLAGE OF ELKHART LAKE
SHEBOYGAN COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

REVISING ZONING ORDINANCE SECTION 16.90 - SIGNS

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of the Village of Elkhart Lake, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That pursuant to the Municipal Code of the Village of Elkhart Lake, Section 16.27, and after considering the recommendation of the Planning Commission, and after hearing the public's comments at a legally noticed public hearing held on May 16, 2011, the zoning ordinance affecting Section 16.90-Signs is hereby amended as follows:

- 16.90(4)(a)(17)** Sandwich Board signs limited to one (1) per business or tenant and not exceeding eight (8) square feet per side display area, with a maximum of twenty-four (24) inches, shall not be placed in the street right-of-way, on sidewalks, or in any other public right-of-way, and can only be displayed during regular business hours; and,
- 16.90(5)(f)** Signs in the C-1, C-2, C-3, and C-4 Districts shall only advertise on-site businesses and events. In instances where the property owner or business tenant wishes to erect a sandwich board, refer to the regulations for sandwich board signs under 16.90(4)(a); and,
- 16.90(10)(a)(3)** Contractor/subcontractor signs no larger than six (6) square feet may be erected for a maximum of the length of time the contractor is performing work at the site, but not to exceed 90 days.

BE IT RESOLVED, that this ordinance will become effective upon its publication and posting.
