

Foot Golf Rules

1) Please be respectful of soccer players, Foot Golf players and everyone in the park.

2) Refer to the Foot Golf map for routing of each hole and return your pencil upon completion.

3) Start by placing the ball at the tee, then kick the ball towards the hole. Do not punt the ball or stop the ball from rolling with the wind.

4) The ball must be played in a single movement. You are not allowed to push the ball with the top or bottom of your foot.

5) Play the ball on the ground when it has come to rest. Like golf, each kick is considered a stroke.

6) Wait your turn, make sure your kick will not interfere with other players.

7) Play the ball from where it lies. EXCEPTION: You may mark the spot and lift the ball if it may obstruct another player's kick or ball.

8) The order of play is based on your score on the previous hole. The player with the best score kicks first.

9) On the Foot Golf Course, the player farthest from the hole is the first to kick the ball.
